- Techniques to remember tables and concepts are being shared in class.
- Phonics are taught with letter sounds in LKG and UKG. From Class 1 onwards the words are taught with the help of syllables.
- As per CBSE guidelines 30% of the syllabus is reduced for the present academic year only. The concepts will be taught to the students as they are important for higher classes. The deducted lessons will not be assessed in the exams.
- Revision of lessons and worksheets for half yearly and annual exams will be done.
- Teachers follow a slow pace while teaching. Encourage students to ask questions and clear their doubts during class only.
- Syllabus is equally distributed between half yearly and annually.
- Life skills and extra-curricular classes will be interactive
- Class Work and Home work will be assessed for Internal Assessments.
- Periodic Tests are designed differently every time to assess the child in all areas.
- Parents are requested to monitor the student's usage in electronic devices. Lock the apps if child plays games.

Questions

- As per CBSE guidelines HW is given for one subject only so that students have time to revise all the subjects covered that day.
- Regular classes for IX and X will be scheduled as per the guidelines of Telangana State Government and CBSE.

Suggestions

- Private chat is being disabled by the teacher, and is enabled only when required.
- Periodic Tests will be designed as per the class level and assessment level will be increased gradually.

- As per the government orders special classes cannot be conducted.
- Random checks by Mam, and in- charges is being done regularly to keep students alert.
