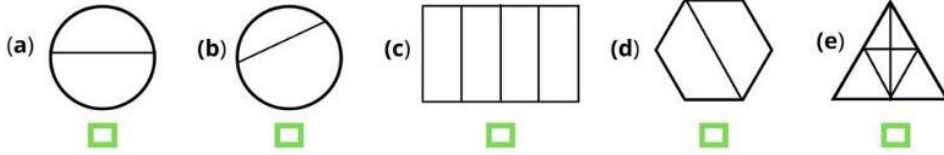

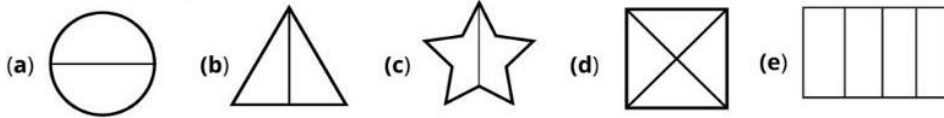

1. Put a tick in the box for the shape that is divided into equal parts.



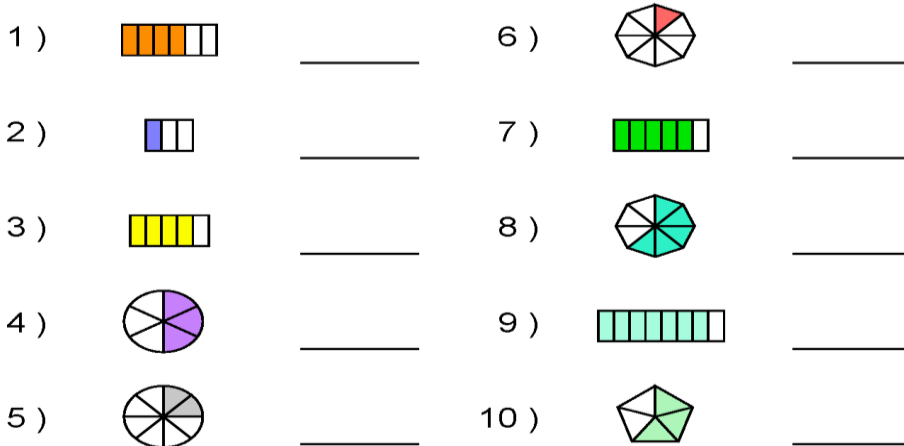

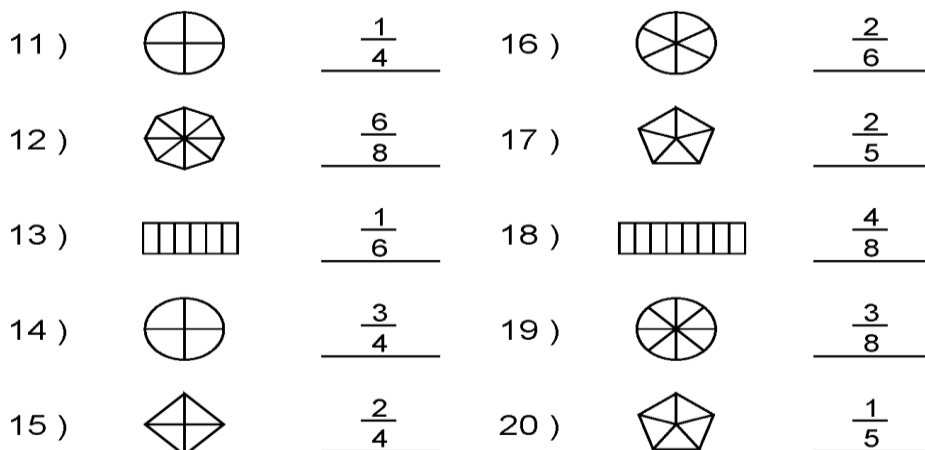
