









Moderate level Q1:




60 children could identify the picture and say the body part, but were unable to speak in sentences.

Moderate level Q2:




22 children could identify the picture as hand but were unable to identify the fingers.

Moderate level Q3:




32 children were unable to identify how many toes we have.
