To provide immediate medical care and to ensure a safe and healthy school environment a nurse's station has been set up in the school lobby from July 9th 2024. The services of the nurses have been hired from neighbouring - Prasad's hospital.

Importance of a Nurse's Station in School is to provide

1. Immediate Medical Attention:

 Minor Injuries and Illnesses: The nurse's station provides a place for students to receive immediate care for minor injuries like cuts, bruises, or sprains, and common illnesses such as headaches, stomach aches, and fevers. • Emergency Situations: In case of emergencies, such as severe asthma attacks, allergic reactions, or injuries, the school nurse can provide initial medical care and stabilize the student until further help arrives.

2. Health Monitoring and Management:

• **Infectious Diseases:** The nurse's station helps in identifying and managing outbreaks of infectious diseases, ensuring that proper protocols are followed to minimize the spread within the school.

3. Health Education and Promotion:

• **Health Awareness Programs:** Nurses organize and participate in health awareness programs and campaigns that promote well-being and educate students on various health issues.
